Fresh Malaysian durians for China after trade deals signed during Li's visit

Fresh Malaysian durians can now be exported to China as the two countries finally signed an export agreement recently during a visit by Premier Li Qiang to celebrate a half-century of diplomatic relations. Exporting fresh durians to China will open a new market for Malaysia, which began selling durian pulp & paste to China in 2011 and frozen durian whole fruits in 2018. Malaysia's frozen durian export value to China has surged from RM 170 million in 2018 to nearly 1.2 billion last year.
